113. STREET NAMING AND NUMBERING

There were no items raised.

114. COMMUNICATIONS

Groves Nursery Application - the Town Clerk reported that he had been copied into a letter to the District Council, sent on behalf of the applicant for Groves Nursery, regarding their planning application for site improvements. The letter raised concerns regarding the suggestion from West Dorset District Council that the application should be withdrawn, due to the issues raised by the Highways Agency and comments from the Landscape Officer.

The Committee asked that it receive an update on progress with this application at its next meeting. It also agreed that the Town Clerk should contact West Dorset District Council to seek clarification and to see if the concerns raised could be addressed, to allow the application to be determined and not have to be withdrawn. Members reiterated their support for the application, particularly in respect of the potential new employment generation from the scheme.

Planning Web Site - during consideration of the applications, the Committee commented on the changes to the planning web site and specifically asked if the following matters could be raised with West Dorset District Council:

- the naming of files had changed and they seemed to have generic names such as "support document". This made finding specific documents, for example a design and access statement, much more difficult.
- PDF maps and plans were still being uploaded the wrong way round.

The Town Clerk said that he would take these matters up with the District Council.

The meeting closed at 7.50 p.m.
