



TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF BROAD LANE, BRIDPORT

DORSET COUNTY COUNCIL has made an Order under Section 14 [1] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 as amended. All vehicles will be prohibited from proceeding along BROAD LANE, BRIDPORT between Farthings Mead and Foxgloves, a distance of 250 metres.

The order is needed in order to comply with Health and Safety Regulations which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise the likelihood of danger to Highway Users. It will come into operation on 6 December 2018 and will remain in force for 18 months. However it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 19 December 2018.

This order will enable Western Power Distribution safe access to excavate and erect poles and reconductor overhead powerlines.

An alternative vehicular route will be signed; Skilling Hill Road - West Bay Road - A35 - Broad Lane
