



TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF NORTH ALLINGTON, BRIDPORT

DORSET COUNTY COUNCIL has issued a Notice under Section 14 [2] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 as amended. All vehicles will be prohibited from proceeding along NORTH ALLINGTON, BRIDPORT from its junction with Mount Pleasant to its junction with Portland Place, a distance of 5 metres. The order is needed in order to comply with Health and Safety Regulations which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise likelihood of danger to Highway Users. It will come into operation on the 6 February 2019 and remain in force for 5 days. However it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 7 February 2019.

This Notice will enable SGN safe access to carry out new gas connection in the highway

The alternative route which will be sign posted is as follows; B3162 - Fulbrooks Lane - St Swithens Road - B3162
