



**TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF THE ESPLANADE, WEST BAY**

DORSET COUNTY COUNCIL has made an Order under Section 14 [1] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 as amended. All vehicles will be prohibited from proceeding along THE ESPLANADE, WEST BAY for its entirety, a distance of 200 metres. The order is needed in order to comply with Health and Safety Regulations which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise the likelihood of danger to Highway Users. It will come into operation on 4 February 2019 and will remain in force for 18 months. However it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 12 July 2019.

**This order will enable B A M Nuttall Ltd, safe access to carry out beach upgrade works and flood wall repairs/construction.**
