



TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF SHIPTON LANE, BURTON BRADSTOCK

DORSET COUNTY COUNCIL has issued a Notice under Section 14 [2] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 as amended. All vehicles will be prohibited from proceeding along SHIPTON LANE, BURTON BRADSTOCK from its junction with Annings Lane to outside Bridesmead, a distance of approximately 400 metres. The order is needed in order to comply with Health and Safety Regulations which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise likelihood of danger to Highway Users. It will come into operation on the 18 February 2019 and remain in force for 5 days. However it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 18 February 2019.

This Notice will enable BT safe access to complete duct blockages for Openreach and cable the rest of the route in the highway.

The alternative route which will be sign posted is as follows; Shipton Lane - A35 - B3157 Burton Road - Shipton Lane
