

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF PUBLIC FOOTPATH 15, SYMONDSBURY

DORSET COUNCIL has made an Order under Section 14 [1] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984, as amended. All pedestrians will be prohibited from proceeding along Footpath 15, from grid reference SY 464 921 to grid reference ST 464 919, a distance of approximately 225 metres. The Notice is needed in order to comply with health and safety regulations, which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise the likelihood of danger to highway users. It will come into operation on 5 August 2019 for a period of 10 weeks but it will remain in force for 6 months and can be extended with the approval of the Secretary of State for Transport, if necessary.

This closure is required to allow Kier Infrastructure to carry out stabilisation works to flood wall at Palmers Brewery.

There will be a locally signed diversion.
