

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF SKILLING HILL ROAD, BRIDPORT

DORSET COUNCIL has issued a Notice under Section 14 [2] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 as amended. All vehicles will be prohibited from proceeding along SKILLING HILL ROAD, BRIDPORT outside Brithaven, a distance of approximately 140 metres. The Notice is needed in order to comply with health and safety regulations which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise likelihood of danger to highway users. It will come into operation on 20 January 2020 between 0900 and 1500 and remain in force for five days, however it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 20 January 2020.

This Notice will enable Wessex Water safe access to replace 2 x covers and carry out minor works in the highway.

The alternative route, which will be sign posted is as follows: Broad Lane - A35 - West Bay Road - Skilling Hill Road
