

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF GEORGE STREET, WEST BAY, BRIDPORT

DORSET COUNCIL has issued a Notice under Section 14 [2] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 as amended. All vehicles will be prohibited from proceeding along GEORGE STREET, WEST BAY, BRIDPORT between no. 5 George Street and The George Hotel, a distance of approximately 60 metres. The Notice is needed in order to comply with health and safety regulations which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise likelihood of danger to highway users. It will come into operation on 24 February 2020 and remain in force for five days, however it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 28 February 2020.

This Notice will enable Western Power Distribution safe access to carry out road crossing and joint pit for electricity supply upgrade in the highway.

The alternative route, which will be sign posted is as follows: George Street - West Bay Road - North side basin - George Street
