

URGENT TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF FULBROOKS LANE, BRIDPORT

DORSET COUNCIL has issued a Notice under Section 14 [2] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 as amended. All vehicles will be prohibited from proceeding along FULBROOKS LANE, BRIDPORT between its junction with North Allington and its junction with St Swithens Road, a distance of approximately 130 metres. The Notice is needed in order to comply with health and safety regulations which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise likelihood of danger to highway users. It will come into operation on 20 February 2020 and remain in force for five days, however it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 20 February 2020.

This Notice will enable BT safe access to excavate to lay new duct and clear duct blockages in the highway.

The alternative route, which will be sign posted is as follows: St Swithens Road - B3162 North Allington
