

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF BARRACK STREET, BRIDPORT (SATURDAY'S ONLY)

DORSET COUNCIL has made an Order under Section 14 [1] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 as amended. All vehicles will be prohibited from proceeding along BARRACK STREET, BRIDPORT from its junction with B3162 to no. 20, a distance of approximately 95 metres. The Order is needed in order to comply with health and safety regulations which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise the likelihood of danger to highway users. It will come into operation on 20 July 2020, on Saturdays only between 0600 and 1700 and remain in force for 18 months and can be extended with the approval of the Secretary of State for Transport if necessary.

This Order will enable Dorset Council to allow Bridport Town Council to safely facilitate the Farmers Market whilst ensuring social distancing measures can be maintained.

On this occasion there will be no alternative route.
