

## TEMPORARY TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT ORDER, A3066 ST ANDREWS ROAD & SEA ROAD NORTH, BRIDPORT

DORSET COUNCIL has made an Order under Section 14 [1] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 as amended. The Order is needed in order to comply with health and safety regulations, which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise the likelihood of danger to highway users.

The Order will come into effect between 09:00 and 16:00 from 25 August 2020 and will remain in force for five days, however it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 4 September 2020.

**This Notice will enable Dorset Highways to carry out surfacing works.**

The effect of the order is to impose a temporary speed restriction of 10mph within the working area (as indicated by signs on site), at any point along A3066 St Andrews and Sea Road North, Bridport to facilitate the use of a convoy working vehicle.
