

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF SKILLING HILL ROAD, BRIDPORT

DORSET COUNCIL has made a Notice under Section 14 [2] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 as amended. All vehicles will be prohibited from proceeding along SKILLING HILL ROAD, BRIDPORT from its junction with B3157 for a distance of approximately 110 metres in a westerly direction. The Notice is needed in order to comply with health and safety regulations which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise the likelihood of danger to highway users.

It will come into operation on 31 August 2020 between 20:00 and 07:00 and remain in force for five days, but it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 3 September 2020.

This Notice will enable Dorset Council to safely carry out steelwork repairs and maintenance painting of Brewery Bridge.

A locally signed diversion route will be put in place to enable traffic to travel around the closed section.
