

TEMPORARY TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT ORDER, EAST STREET, BRIDPORT - BRIDPORT MARKET

DORSET COUNCIL has issued an Order under Section 14 [1] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 as amended. The Order is needed in order to comply with health and safety regulations which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise likelihood of danger to highway users.

The Order comes in to operation on 5 September 2020 on Saturdays only between 0700 and 1700 and will remain in force for 18 months and will remain in force for 18 months and can be extended with the approval of the Secretary of State for Transport if necessary.

This Order will enable Dorset Council to allow Bridport Town Council to safely facilitate the Bridport Market whilst ensuring social distancing measures can be maintained.

The effect of the Order is as follows:

[1] To suspend the taxi rank bay between Scrivens Opticians and Hays Travel, the length of approximately 3 cars.
