TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF PUBLIC FOOTPATHS 21 & 14, SYMONDSBURY and 26 & 23, BRIDPORT

DORSET COUNCIL has made an Order under Section 14 [1] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984, as amended. All pedestrians will be prohibited from proceeding along the above footpaths from grid references SY 461 913 (point A on the map below) to grid reference SY 462 905 (Point D on map below) a distance of approximately 790 metres, and, from SY 460 912 (point B on the map below) to grid reference SY 460 906 (Point C on map below) a distance of approximately 700 metres. The Notice is needed in order to comply with health and safety regulations, which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise the likelihood of danger to highway users. It will come into operation on 28 December 2020 for a period of 26 weeks and can be extended with the approval of the Secretary of State for Transport, if necessary.

This closure is required due to works to strengthen and re-profile the western riverbank of the River Brit adjacent to West Bay Holiday Park.

On this occasion there is no reasonable alternative route.
