

TEMPORARY TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT NOTICE, VARIOUS ROADS, BRIDPORT

DORSET COUNCIL has issued a Notice under Section 14 [2] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 as amended. The Notice is needed in order to comply with health and safety regulations which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise likelihood of danger to highway users. The Notice comes in to operation on 23rd April 2021 between 0700 and 1700 and will remain in force for 5 days, however it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 29th May 2021.

This Order will enable Dorset Council to carry out carriageway maintenance and resurfacing works.

The effect of this Notice is as follows:.

- [1] To impose temporary road closure on Lee Lane for approximately 800 metres from its junctions of East Road and Trinity Way.
- [2] To impose temporary road closure on Magdalen Lane for approximately 240 metres from its junctions with W Allington and Pine View.
- [3] To impose temporary road closure on Pine View for approximately 275 metres from its junctions with Queens Road and Magdalen Lane.
- [4] To impose temporary road closure on Queens Road for approximately 220 metres from its junctions with Alexandra Road and Pine View.
- [5] To impose temporary road closure on Alexandra Road for approximately 750 metres from its junctions with Skilling Hill Road and Magdalen Lane.
- [6] To impose temporary road closure on Long Lane for approximately 940 metres from its junctions with Marrobone Lane.
- [7] To impose temporary road closure on Coronation Road for approximately 365 metres from its junctions with Alexandra Road and Elizabeth Avenue Road.
- [8] To impose clearway and parking suspension as indicated by signs on site to prevent waiting or parking on the highway along the above roads [1] [2][3] [4][5] [6][7]. Any vehicle waiting in contravention of any restriction imposed by this Notice may be removed under the provisions of the Removal and Disposal of Vehicles Regulations 1986.

Please note that the dates are a window of opportunity and the road may not be closed for the whole duration stated above and the works are weather dependant. A locally signed diversion route will be put in place to enable traffic to travel around the closed section.
