

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF QUAYSIDE AND THE ESPLANADE, WEST BAY

DORSET COUNCIL has issued a Notice under Section 14 [2] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 as amended. All vehicles will be prohibited from proceeding along (i) Quayside between North Side Basin Roundabout and The Esplanade; and (ii) The Esplanade between Quayside and West Cliff Road (in both directions), a total distance of approximately 320 metres. The Notice is needed in order to comply with health and safety regulations and to minimise likelihood of danger to highway users.

It will come into operation on 28 May 2021 between 09:00hrs and 19:00hrs and it is anticipated that the activity will be completed by 30 May 2021 at 19:00hrs; but the Notice will remain valid for five days.

This Notice is required to facilitate the arrangements in connection with the Power Boat Weekend

On this occasion, there will be no signposted alternative route for diverted traffic.
