

## TEMPORARY TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT NOTICE, ROPE WALKS, BRIDPORT

DORSET COUNCIL has issued a Notice under Section 14 [2] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 as amended. The Notice is needed in order to comply with health and safety regulations which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise likelihood of danger to highway users. The Notice comes in to operation on 19 September 2021 and will remain in force for 5 working days. Please note the works will be completed on 2 x Sundays only, 19 & 26 September.

This Notice will enable Jurassic Fibre Limited to lay duct network.

The effect of this Notice is as follows:

- [1] To close Rope Walks from its junction with The Tanyard for a distance of approximately 65metres in a north west direction.
- [2] To revoke one way system on Rope Walks from its junction with Gundry Lane to allow 2 way traffic flow for access only.

There will be a signed diversion in place; St Michaels Lane - Tannery Lane - B3162 - B3157 - Gundry Lane - Rope Walks
