

## TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF STATION ROAD, WEST BAY FOR BONFIRE ON THE BEACH

DORSET COUNCIL has issued a Notice under Section 14 [2] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 as amended. All vehicles will be prohibited from proceeding along Station Road, West Bay between West Bay Road and The West Bay public house (in both directions), a distance of approximately 90 metres. The Notice is needed in order to comply with health and safety regulations which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise likelihood of danger to highway users.

It will come into operation on 30 October 2021 between 16.30hrs and 23.00hrs and remain in force for five days, however it is anticipated that the activity will be completed by 30 October 2021 at 23.00hrs.

**This effect of this Notice will contribute in part to the safe running of the Bonfire on the Beach event.**

There will be no signed alternative route for traffic on this occasion.
