

TEMPORARY TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT NOTICE, B3165, MARSHWOOD

DORSET COUNCIL has issued a Notice under Section 14 [2] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 as amended. The Notice is needed in order to comply with health and safety regulations which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise likelihood of danger to highway users. The Notice comes in to operation on 15th November 2021 between 09:00 until 16:00 and will remain in force for 5 days, however it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 17th November 2021.

This Order will enable Dorset Council to carry out carriageway maintenance and resurfacing works.

The effect of this Notice is as follows:

The effect of this Order is as follows:

[1] To impose a temporary road closure on B3165, Marshwood from the junction with Hawkmoor Hill to a point 100 metres to the east of Mutton Street (in both directions), an overall distance of approximately 2360 metres. A locally signed diversion route will be put in place to enable traffic to travel around the closed sections.

[2] To impose clearway and parking suspension as indicated by signs on site to prevent waiting or parking on B3165, Marshwood from the junction with Hawkmoor Hill to a point 100 metres to the east of Mutton Street (in both directions), an overall distance of approximately 2360 metres. Any vehicle waiting in contravention of any restriction imposed by this Notice may be removed under the provisions of the Removal and Disposal of Vehicles Regulations 1986.
