

Here are some contact points which may be helpful to Ukrainian refugees arriving in the Bridport area, and their hosts.



• On **Tuesdays at 3pm, Quakers' Hall** in South Street (opposite the Church): Ukrainian guests, their hosts, and local people offering support or wishing to do so, meet to exchange news, experiences and information. This is an opportunity for Ukrainian guests to meet face-to-face and chat. The group is expanding rapidly.

• Bridport Ukraine Volunteer Group:

A fund-raising group who operate a pop-up clothes outlet on St Michael's Trading Estate until the end of May. Their clothing is free to Ukrainian guests. After May their Facebook page "**Bridport to Ukraine**" will continue to operate as a contact point for help and advice of all sorts.
