

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF THE ESPLANADE AND PART OF QUAYSIDE, WEST BAY FOR POWERBOAT WEEKEND

DORSET COUNCIL has issued a Notice under Section 14 [2] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 as amended. The Notice is needed in order to comply with health and safety regulations which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise likelihood of danger to highway users. It will come into operation from 1800 on 08 July 2022 and remain in force for five days, however it is anticipated that the activity will be completed by 1800 on 10 July 2022.

This Notice is required to facilitate the arrangements in connection with the Power Boat Weekend.

The effect of this Notice is as follows:

To impose temporary road closures on;

- [1] Quayside from the roundabout to where it meets the Esplanade.
- [2] The Esplanade in its entirety.
