

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF PUBLIC FOOTPATH 1, BRIDPORT

DORSET COUNCIL has made an Order under Section 14 [1] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984, as amended. **All pedestrians will be prohibited from proceeding along FOOTPATH W1/1, from grid reference SY 463 933 (point A on the map below) to grid reference SY 464 932 (point B on the map below) a distance of approximately 180 metres.** The Order is needed in order to comply with health and safety regulations, which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise the likelihood of danger to highway users. **It will come into operation on 01 August 2022 for a period of 12 weeks** but it will remain in force for 6 months and can be extended with the approval of the Secretary of State for Transport, if necessary.

This Order is required to allow the Environment Agency to repair a section of the River Brit flood bank.

Alternative route; Head south from POINT A along St Swithins Road to the bridge at POINT C (SY463931). From here, cross the bridge and proceed southeast to re-join footpath W1/1.
