

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF VARIOUS ROADS, BRIDPORT FOR BRIDPORT CARNIVAL

DORSET COUNCIL has issued an Order under Section 16A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 to prohibit the use of the following roads by cyclists, horse riders and all mechanically propelled vehicles, except those taking part in the event and emergency vehicles, to facilitate a public event on the highway.

On Saturday 20 August 2022 as follows:

To impose temporary road closures on;

- West Allington in its entirety - 1600 to 2000
- Part West Road, from the access road of Symondsburys Estate to West Allington - 1600 to 2000
- South Street in its entirety - 1830 to 2130
- West Street in its entirety - 1830 to 2130
- Part South Street, from its junction with West Street to its junction with Gundry Lane - 1830 to 0000 (midnight)

The alternative route for diverted traffic will be via: West Road - A35 - Sea Road South - B3162 East Street
