

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF FULBROOKS LANE, BRIDPORT

DORSET COUNCIL has issued a Notice under Section 14 [2] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 as amended. All vehicles will be prohibited from proceeding along Fulbrooks Lane, Bridport between 16 Fulbrooks Lane and 29 Fulbrooks Lane (in both directions), a distance of approximately 50 metres. The Notice is needed in order to comply with health and safety regulations which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise likelihood of danger to highway users. It will come into operation between 08:00 and 17:00 on 10th October 2022 and remain in force for five days, however it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 12th October 2022.

This Notice will enable Jurassic Fibre Limited safe access to dig to remove a blockage in the highway.

The alternative route, which will be sign posted is as follows: St Swithins Road - North Allington
