

## TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF FULBROOKS LANE, BRIDPORT

DORSET COUNCIL has issued a Notice under Section 14 [2] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 as amended. All vehicles will be prohibited from proceeding along FULBROOKS LANE, BRIDPORT between its junction with B3162 and its junction with St Swithins Road, a distance of approximately 150 metres. The Notice is needed in order to comply with health and safety regulations which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise likelihood of danger to highway users. It will come into operation on 06 February 2023 and remain in force for five days, however it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 09 February 2023.

**This Notice will enable Openreach safe access to underground structure.**

The alternative route, which will be sign posted is as follows: B3162 - St Swithins Road
