

TEMPORARY TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT NOTICE OF SOUTH STREET, BRIDPORT

DORSET COUNCIL has made a Notice under Section 14 [2] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 as amended. The Notice is needed in order to comply with health and safety regulations which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise the likelihood of danger to highway users. It will come into operation on 06 February 2023 between 0900 and 1600 and remain in force for five days, but it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 09 February 2023.

This Notice will enable Dorset Council to carry out carriageway maintenance works.

The effect of this Notice is as follows:

[1] To impose a temporary road closure on SOUTH STREET, BRIDPORT between its junction with Skilling Hill Road and its junction with B3162, a distance of approximately 765 metres, as indicated by signs on site.

[2] To impose a clearway on SOUTH STREET, BRIDPORT between its junction with Skilling Hill Road and its junction with B3162, as indicated by signs on site, to prevent waiting or parking on the highway, a distance of approximately 765 metres

Any vehicle waiting in contravention of any restriction imposed by this Notice may be removed under the provisions of the Removal and Disposal of Vehicles Regulations 1986. A locally signed diversion route will be put in place to enable traffic to travel around the closed section.
