

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF RIVERSIDE, WEST BAY

DORSET COUNCIL has made a Notice under Section 14 [2] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 as amended. All vehicles will be prohibited from proceeding along RIVERSIDE, WEST BAY between its junction with North Side Basin and its junction with George Street, a distance of approximately 55 metres. The Notice is needed in order to comply with health and safety regulations which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise the likelihood of danger to highway users. It will come into operation on 27 November 2023 between 0900 and 1600 and remain in force for five days, but it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 29 November 2023.

This Notice will enable Dorset Council to carry out carriageway maintenance works.

A locally signed diversion route will be put in place to enable traffic to travel around the closed section.
