
Bridport Town Council – Draft Committee Structure for 1 April 2024 (updated Nov 2023)



- Full Council predominantly adoption of committee minutes/decisions, strategic motions, creation/removal of committees, election of Mayor/Leader/committee memberships, budget/precept, Annual Return, resolution of relevant WG/committee/sub-committee recommendations, sole trustee to Bridport Communities Trust.
- Bridport Communities Trust Management Committee operational management of the Trust.
- Environment & Social Wellbeing cross-council initiatives within its remit, resolution of relevant WG/committee/sub-committee recommendations, Climate Emergency Action Plan.
- Planning Committee planning application comments, highways and transportation matters, resolution of relevant WG/committee/sub-committee recommendations, decisions for BTC arising from NPJCC.
- Neighbourhood Plan JCC monitoring and review of the Bridport Area Neighbourhood Plan (joint with Symondsbury Parish Council).
- Finance & General Purposes Committee all financial and other matters not delegated to committees, recommendation of budget and precept, resolution of relevant WG/committee/sub-committee recommendations.
- Best Value & Scrutiny Sub-Committee review of corporate governance, including scrutiny of Standing Orders, Financial Regulations, audit arrangements, and performance.
- Ward Working Groups ward-based initiatives/projects, ward-based planning applications. Recommendations to F&GP or decisions approved under scheme of delegation as appropriate, unless specific to another committee remit. Bothenhampton & Walditch and West Bay ward business combined for administrative ease, but ward-specific business would be separate agenda items. Can include external stakeholder membership.
- Market & Business Liaison WG oversight of markets, links with the business community, economic development matters. Recommendations to F&GP or decisions approved under scheme of delegation as appropriate, unless specific to another committee remit.

Note:

- 1. This draft structure has no constitutional standing and has not been approved by Bridport Town Council. It remains a discussion document.
- 2. The Town Council may decide to adopt this or a different structure prior to the election of a new council in May 2024, but the new council may decide to change it at or after its first meeting.
- 3. The Town Council's Scheme of Delegation would require amendment if this structure were to be adopted.
