

PROPOSED TEMPORARY TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT NOTICE, B3162, BRIDPORT

I have received an application from National Grid

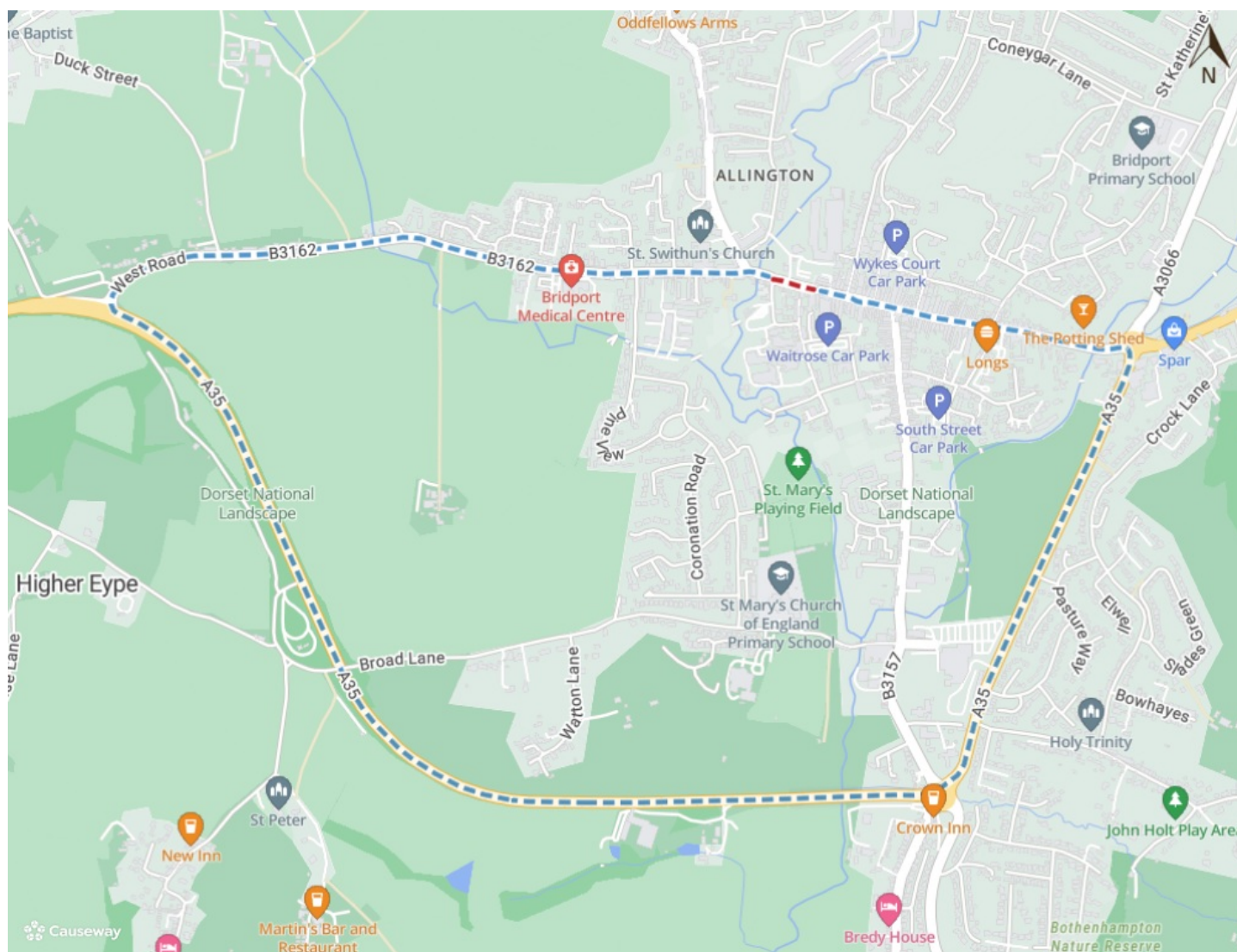
[1] To revoke two way traffic flow on B3162, BRIDPORT between the roundabout with Tannery Road and the zebra crossing, a distance of approximately 120 metres, as indicated by signs on site.

[2] To impose temporary one way traffic flow westbound on B3162, BRIDPORT between the roundabout with Tannery Road and the zebra crossing, a distance of approximately 120 metres, as indicated by signs on site.

The restriction has been requested to allow National Grid to replace high voltage underground cables. These works are programmed to commence from 23 September 2024 until 27 September 2024.

National Grid will publicise the restriction in a number of ways: they will place information boards on the road in this area to inform the travelling public of the works; they will carry out a letter drop to local residents directly affected by the works; and they will sign a vehicular diversion route using the local road network. The following map shows the extent of the restriction and the diversion route.
