

TEMPORARY TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT ORDER OF A3066, BRIDPORT

DORSET COUNCIL has made an Order under Section 14 [1] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 as amended. The Order is needed in order to comply with health and safety regulations which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise the likelihood of danger to highway users. It will come into operation on 09 September 2024 and will remain in force for 18 months, however it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 23 October 2024.

This Order will enable National Grid Company safe access to carry out a network reinforcement scheme.

The effect of the Order is as follows:

[1] To impose a parking suspension as indicated by signs on site to prevent parking on the highway along A3066, BRIDPORT between its junction with St Katherine's Drive and its junction with Shoe Lane, a distance of approximately 400 metres.

[2] To impose a clearway as indicated by signs on site to prevent waiting on the highway along A3066, BRIDPORT between its junction with St Katherine's Drive and its junction with Shoe Lane, a distance of approximately 400 metres.
