

PROPOSED TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF VARIOUS ROADS, WEST BAY

I have received an application from National Grid to close VARIOUS ROADS, WEST BAY;

NORTH SIDE BASIN between its junction with George Street and its junction with B3157, a distance of approximately 50 metres.

BRIDPORT ARMS ROAD, in its entirety.

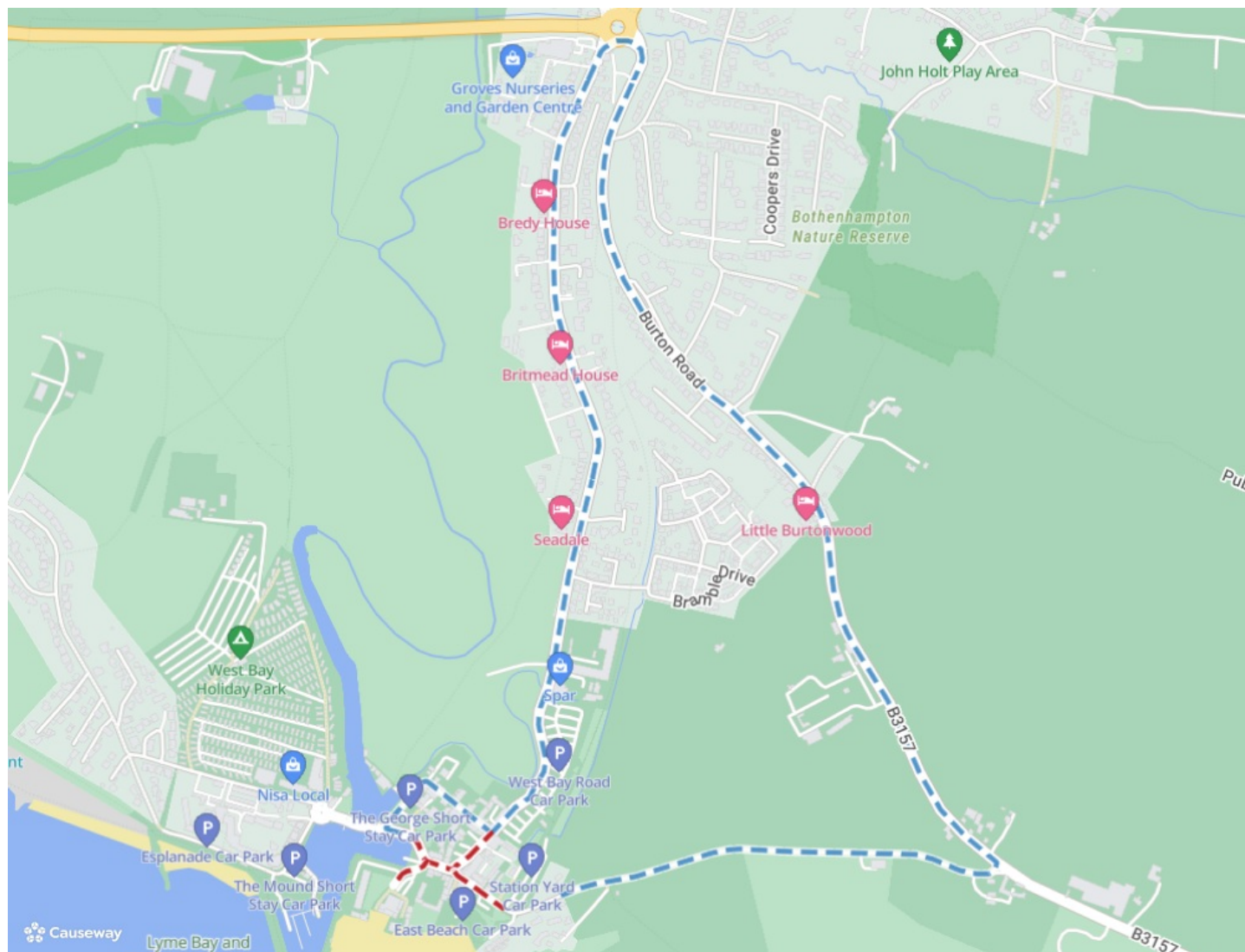
B3157 between its junction with North Side Basin and its junction with George Street, a distance of approximately 130 metres.

STATION ROAD between its junction with B3157 and the entrance to Station Yard car park, a distance of approximately 105 metres.

The closure has been requested to allow National Grid to carry out electricity pole changes and re conductoring. These works are programmed to commence from 0830 until 1730 on 02 October 2024.

National Grid will publicise the road closures in a number of ways: they will place information boards on the road in this area to inform the travelling public of the works; they will carry out a letter drop to local residents directly affected by the works; and they will sign a vehicular diversion route using the local road network. The following map shows the extent of the closures and the diversion route.
