

## TEMPORARY TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT NOTICE, B3162, BRIDPORT

DORSET COUNCIL has issued a Notice under Section 14 [2] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 as amended. The Notice is needed in order to comply with health and safety regulations which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise likelihood of danger to highway users. The Notice comes in to operation on 23 September 2024 and will remain in force for 5 days, however it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 27 September 2024.

**This Notice will enable National Grid to replace high voltage underground cables.**

The effect of this Notice is as follows:

[1] To revoke two way traffic flow on B3162, BRIDPORT between the roundabout with Tannery Road and the zebra crossing, a distance of approximately 120 metres, as indicated by signs on site.

[2] To impose temporary one way traffic flow westbound on B3162, BRIDPORT between the roundabout with Tannery Road and the zebra crossing, a distance of approximately 120 metres, as indicated by signs on site.
