

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF THE ESPLANADE AND PART OF QUAYSIDE, WEST BAY FOR POWERBOAT WEEKEND

DORSET COUNCIL has issued a Notice under Section 14 [2] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 as amended. The Notice is needed in order to comply with health and safety regulations which require the provision of safe event areas and to minimise likelihood of danger to highway users. It will come into operation from 0900 on 02 May 2025 and remain in force for five days, however it is anticipated that the activity will be completed by 1900 on 04 May 2025.

This Notice is required to facilitate the arrangements in connection with the Power Boat Weekend.

The effect of this Notice is as follows:

To impose temporary road closures on;

[1] Quayside from the roundabout to where it meets the Esplanade.

[2] The Esplanade in its entirety.

There will be no alternative route signed for traffic on this occasion.
