

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF KING STREET, BRIDPORT

DORSET COUNCIL has made an Order under Section 14 [1] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 as amended. All vehicles will be prohibited from proceeding along KING STREET, BRIDPORT between its junction with B3162 and 2, King Street, a distance of approximately 25 metres. The Order is needed in order to comply with health and safety regulations which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise the likelihood of danger to highway users. It will come into operation on 23 June 2025 and will remain in force for 18 months, however it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 04 August 2025.

This Order will enable South Coast Traffic Management to provide safe working area for scaffolding and roofing works to a property.

On this occasion there will be no specified alternative route for diverted traffic.
