

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF MANGERTON LANE, BRIDPORT

DORSET COUNCIL has issued a Notice under Section 14 [2] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 as amended. All vehicles will be prohibited from proceeding along MANGERTON LANE, BRIDPORT between its junction with Townsend Way and the entrance to Old House Farm, a distance of approximately 345 metres. The Notice is needed in order to comply with health and safety regulations which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise likelihood of danger to highway users. It will come into operation between 0930 and 1530 on 14 August 2025 and remain in force for five days, however it is anticipated that the works will be completed on 14 August 2025.

This Notice will enable Openreach safe access to provide new customer service.

The alternative route, which will be sign posted is as follows: C44 - C66 - B3163 - A3066
