# 32. RE-ADOPTION OF THE GENERAL POWER OF COMPETENCE

Following the last meeting of this Committee, it was agreed that the General Power of Competence should be reinstated.

RESOLVED: (1) that the Council has met the eligibility criteria to use the General Power of Competence as set out in the Parish Councils (General Power of Competence) (Prescribed Conditions) Order 2012; and (2) that Bridport Town Council's use of the General Power of Competence be reinstated.

#### 33. WITHDRAWAL OF FUNDING SUPPORT FOR NEIGHBOURHOOD PLANS

The Committee considered a response from the Town Council, ENCL: 4027, to the announcement by the Ministry of Housing, Communities, and Local Government (MHCLG) that it will cease commissioning new neighbourhood planning support services. Following the discussion it was put to a vote,12 councillors agreed and 1 abstained, and it was:

RESOLVED: that the letter included as appendix 1 in the report be sent to Edward Morello MP and the Ministry of Housing, Communities, and Local Government to continue with financial support for Neighbourhood Plans.

#### 34. COMMUNICATIONS

The Mayor reported that the latest edition of the Mayor's Blog was now available.

The Leader of the Council explained that the Service Level Agreement reviews were being completed and suggested that it would be useful to have feedback from any Councillors who were involved with the groups affected.

Concern was raised regarding the closure of the Police Station, and it was clarified that the Police Station front desk would be closed but the time scale for this was not clear. Whilst the Police Station was only open to the public three mornings a week at present, it was felt that it is important to distinguish between community work and those requiring Police assistance. An opportunity to ask questions of the Dorset Police and Crime Commissioner was required; he would therefore be invited to the next meeting of the Council.
