Food and Clothes Support in Bridport

Bridport Community Fridge: Located at Chapel in the Garden, East Street. Open Tuesdays and Saturday mornings from 10 - 11 (or until supplies run out). Offers food that would otherwise be thrown away to reduce food waste. Anyone can collect.

Bridport Community Food Stall (formerly The Glut Stall): Located at St Swithun's Church, North Allington. Open Thursdays from 9.30 - 10.30. Provides food from shops, individuals, and growers that would otherwise go to waste. Includes a rail of clothes and shoes maintained by Bridport Clothes Bank. On the 1st Thursday of the month, there is a community cafe alongside in St Swithun's Hall.

Bridport Food Bank: At St Marys Church, South Street: Open Wednesdays 11 - 1 pm for food collection (referral system in place, but first-time collection can be without referral). Food donations accepted from 9 - 1 pm.

At Bridport Youth and Community Centre: Open Mondays 5 pm - 7 pm.

Bridport Clothes Bank:

Clothes available during Bridport Food Bank at St Marys Church and St Swithun's Church Hall (see above). In addition, Bridport Youth and Community Centre is filled with clothing, bedding, household items, and more on the 1st Saturday of each month. All items are free of charge. Donations are welcomed and updates are available on their Facebook page. Drop off points include Bridport Leisure Centre, Bridport Town Council at Mountfield and small bags can go to Discount Furniture Store on St Michael's Trading Estate.

Beacon Church Community Kitchen: Located on Priory Lane (behind Rockburn). Offers home-cooked lunches on Wednesdays and Fridays. Provides showers and clothes washing facilities for rough sleepers.
