

## TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF HOLLOW WAY, BOTHENHAMPTON

DORSET COUNCIL has made an Order under Section 14 [1] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 as amended. All vehicles will be prohibited from proceeding along HOLLOW WAY, BOTHENHAMPTON, between its junction with Lansdowne Road and its junction with Crook Lane, a distance of approximately 225 metres. The Order is needed in order to comply with health and safety regulations which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise the likelihood of danger to highway users. It will come into operation on 05 January 2026 and remain in force for 18 months however it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 30 January 2026.

**This Order will enable Dorset Council to carry out works following a landslip.**

A locally signed diversion route will be put in place to enable traffic to travel around the closed sections.
