

TEMPORARY TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT ORDER, VARIOUS ROADS, BRIDPORT FOR BRIDPORT MARKET

DORSET COUNCIL has made an Order under Section 16A of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 as amended. The Order is needed in order to comply with health and safety regulations which require the provision of safe areas. The Order comes in to operation on 04 February 2026 on Wednesdays and Saturdays only, between 0600 and 1700 and will remain in force for 18 months, however it is anticipated that the restrictions will be lifted on 01 February 2027.

This Order will enable Bridport Town Council safe access to facilitate the Bridport Market

The effect of the Order is as follows:

- [1] South Street between the book shop (no.11) and the launderette (no.19), loading bay & disabled parking bay to be suspended
- [2] South Street outside Bridport Library, Permit (C)/restricted one hour parking bay to be suspended
- [3] East Street between the junction with South Street and no.14, parking restrictions & loading bay to be suspended
- [4] South Street between Gundry Lane and Toymaster (no. 44), 1 hour bays to be suspended to provide parking for residents Permit Holders (C)
