

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF SKILLING HILL ROAD, BRIDPORT

DORSET COUNCIL has issued a Notice under Section 14 [2] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 as amended. All vehicles will be prohibited from proceeding along SKILLING HILL ROAD, BRIDPORT between the entrance to The Skilling and steps to the public footpath, a distance of approximately 130 metres. The Notice is needed in order to comply with health and safety regulations which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise likelihood of danger to highway users. It will come into operation between 0930 and 1330 on 02 March 2026 and remain in force for five days, however it is anticipated that the works will be completed on 02 March 2026.

This Notice will enable Wessex Water safe access to replace a cover.

The alternative route, which will be sign posted is as follows: B3157 - A35 - Broad Lane
