

TEMPORARY TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT ORDER OF VARIOUS ROADS, BRIDPORT

DORSET COUNCIL has made an Order under Section 14 [1] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 as amended. The Order is needed in order to comply with health and safety regulations which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise likelihood of danger to highway users. The Order comes in to operation between 2000 and 0600 on 11 March 2026 and will remain in force for 18 months, however it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 21 March 2026.

This Order will enable Miles Mcadam and Dorset Council to carry out carriageway surfacing works.

The effect of the Order is as follows:

- [1] To impose a temporary road closure on ST SWITHINS ROAD, BRIDPORT in its entirety.
- [2] To impose a parking suspension, as indicated by signs on site, to prevent parking on the highway along ST SWITHINS ROAD, BRIDPORT in its entirety.
- [3] To impose a clearway, as indicated by signs on site, to prevent waiting on the highway along ST SWITHINS ROAD, BRIDPORT in its entirety.
- [4] To impose a temporary road closure on ARMSTRONG ROAD, BRIDPORT between its junction with St Swithins Road and a point approximately 60 metres north.
- [5] To impose a parking suspension, as indicated by signs on site, to prevent parking on the highway along ARMSTRONG ROAD, BRIDPORT between its junction with St Swithins Road and a point approximately 60 metres north.
- [6] To impose a clearway, as indicated by signs on site, to prevent waiting on the highway along ARMSTRONG ROAD, BRIDPORT between its junction with St Swithins Road and a point approximately 60 metres north.
